

“For there are... ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness” (Jude 4)

“For I say unto you that unless your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the Kingdom of Heaven.” {Jesus of Nazareth(Matthew 5.20)}

The commandments in the New Pact

1° COMMANDMENT (Exodus 20:3) “Thou shalt have no other gods before Me.”

Mark 12: 29-30 “And Jesus answered him, “The first of all the commandments is: ‘Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God is one Lord. ³⁰And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength;’ this is the first commandment.”

2° COMMANDMENT(Exodus 20:4-6) “Do not make idols (idolatry) that look like anything in the sky ...”

Ephesians 5.5-6 “For this ye know: that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, **nor covetous man who is an idolater**, hath any inheritance in the Kingdom of Christ and of God. ⁶Let no man deceive you with vain words, for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience.”

3° COMMANDMENT (Exodus 20:7) “Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain...”

Matthew 7:21-23 “Not every one that saith unto Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter into the Kingdom of Heaven,... ²²Many will say to Me in that Day, ‘Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Thy name, and in Thy name have cast out devils, and in Thy name done many wonderful works?’ ²³And then will I profess unto them, ‘I never knew you: depart from Me, ye that work iniquity.’”

4° COMMANDMENT(Exodus 20:8-11) “Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy...”

Hebrews 4:9-11“there doth remain, then, a sabbatic rest (¹)to the people of God,¹⁰for he who did enter into his rest, he also rested from his works, as God from His own. ¹¹May we be diligent, then, to enter into that rest, that no one in the same example of the unbelief may fall.”

5° COMMANDMENT (Exodus 20:12) “Honor thy father and thy mother...”

Ephesians 6:2 “Honor thy father and mother, which is the first commandment with promise: ³that it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth.”

6° COMMANDMENT (Exodus 20:13) “Thou shalt not kill” (רצחratsákj; root: to tear into pieces, specifically murder a human being)

Matthew 5:21-26 “You know that our ancestors were told, “Do not murder”...²²But I promise you that if you are angry with someone,you will have to stand trial. If you call someone a fool, you will be taken to court. And if you say that someone is worthless, you will be in danger of the fires of hell.”

7° COMMANDMENT (Exodus 20:14) “Thou shalt not commit adultery” (נאףnaáf;=>illegitimate relations, homosexuality, prostitution, zoophilia, etc.)²

Matthew 5:27 “Ye have heard that it was said by them of old, ‘Thou shalt not commit adultery.’ ²⁸But I say unto you, that whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.”

Ephesians 5.3 “But fornication and all uncleanness or covetousness, let them not once be named among you, as becometh saints”

8° COMMANDMENT (Exodus 20:15) “Thou shalt not steal”

Ephesians 4.28 “Let him that stole steal no more, but rather let him labor, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth.”

9° COMMANDMENT(Exodus 20:16) “Do not tell lies about others” (שקרsheqer; falseness, lie)

Acts 5.3-10 “³But Peter said, “Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost...? ⁴...Thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God. ⁵And Ananias, hearing these words, fell down and gave up the ghost...⁹Then Peter said unto her, “How is it that ye have agreed together to tempt the Spirit of the Lord? Behold, the feet of those who have buried thy husband are at the door and shall carry thee out. ¹⁰Then she fell down straightway at his feet and yielded up the ghost. And the young men came in and found her dead and, carrying her forth, buried her by her husband.”

Colossians 3.9“Do not lie one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds”

Ephesians 4.25“Therefore, putting away lying, let every man speak truth with his neighbor, for we are members one of another.”

10° COMMANDMENT(Exodus 20:17) “Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's house;... thy neighbor's wife.”

1 Corinthians 10.6 “Now these things were our examples, to the intent that we should not lust after evil things, as they also lusted.”

1 Timothy 6.10 “For the love of money is the root of all evil; and while some have coveted after it, they have erred from the faith...”
